1. Definition of Vision

English says "vision", which means "vision, seeing, view, dream, or image." "Vision" comes from the word "see", which means the ability to see the basis of a problem. According to Sulastri et al. (2024), a vision is a statement of ideals, a form of the future, which is connected to the past and is a continuation of the present. According to Ali (2006), vision is the goal desired by every member of the organization.

According to Syaifuddin (2007), vision is a moral imagination that describes the desired school profile in the future. 2. Definition of Mission

Mission comes from the English word mission, which means "task" or mission. Mission is a general statement of an ongoing nature by top management that contains organizational goals. Mission, according to Ali (2006), is a statement of goals expressed in the form of goods and services that can be provided, community groups that can be served, values that can be obtained, and future goals. Mission is an action or effort to realize a vision (Sutiah et al., 2021; Syaifuddin, 2007; PS et al., 2022). Based on the opinions of several experts, it can be concluded that the mission is an operational explanation of the vision.

The mission functions are:

- a. As a basis for formulating goals.
- b. As concrete action to realize the vision.
- c. It is a form of commitment from interested parties.
- d. As a tool to direct strategy formulation and implementation.
- e. As motivation and generating a spirit of togetherness in the organization.

3. Understanding Goals

Goals are goals that a person or group of people who carry out certain activities want to achieve. Goals are an explanation of the mission statement, namely something that must be achieved or created within a certain time period. Goals, according to Mohammad Syaifuddin (2007), are the first step in realizing the school vision that has been proclaimed. In educational units, goals consist of "what" will be achieved or created by the school concerned and "when" these goals will be achieved (Nazarudin, 2020; Amal et al., 2022; Natsir et al., 2022). 4. Definition and Pattern of Kindergarten

Chapter I Article 1 Paragraph 14 of Law of the Republic of Indonesia Number 20 of 2003 concerning the national education system states that early childhood education is a coaching effort aimed at children from birth to the age of six which is carried out through educational stimulation to help physical growth and development and the child's spirituality so that the child is ready to enter further education.

Next, Mansur describes early childhood education as follows:

- a. First, early childhood education is providing efforts to stimulate, guide, nurture and provide learning activities that will produce abilities and skills in children.
- b. Second, early childhood education is a form of implementation that focuses on laying the foundation for physical, intelligence, socio-emotional, language and communication growth and development.
- c. Third, early childhood education is education that is adapted to the stages of development that young children go through.

"Early childhood education is a form of education that focuses on laying the foundation in several directions, namely physical growth and development, intelligence, and socio-emotional language and communication," said Maimunah Hasan. Talking about the concept of Kindergarten, we will first discuss several definition. According to Article 28 Paragraph (3) of the Explanation of Republic of Indonesia Law Number 20 of 2003 concerning the National Education System, kindergarten is a type of education that aims to develop the personality and potential of students according to their next stage of development, as follows stated in the Decree of the Minister of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia Number 0486/U/1992, "Kindergarten education is a forum for helping the physical and spiritual growth and development of students in accordance with the child's natural characteristics.

According to Government Regulation Number 27 of 1990 concerning Preschool Education Chapter I Article 1 Paragraph (2), "Kindergarten is a form of preschool education that provides early education programs for children aged four years until they enter basic education." Kindergarten is a form of preschool education in the formal education pathway which provides educational programs for children aged four to six years. Based on the definitions above, Kindergarten is early childhood education which aims to help children aged birth to six years develop holistically, including physical and non-physical development. Kindergarten also helps children grow optimally by providing the right stimulation for physical, spiritual, motoric, intellectual, emotional and social development. In addition, kindergartens link family education and children's education.

5. Important elements that play a role in kindergarten management

Teachers must be adept at creating and managing their learning environments, as well as providing important recommendations to achieve the desired learning environment. This is an important component of managing the learning environment in kindergarten. To create a good learning environment, support from school facilities and policies is needed (Ingtyas et al., 2021; Purba et al., 2019). The role of parents and the community will support children's school programs.

Below there are various supports provided in the form of School Facilities and Policies:

- a. Children's learning equipment and materials, such as: tables, chairs, books, stationery and colored pencils.
- b. Children's school supplies and equipment, such as school uniforms, sports clothes, shoes, children's personal equipment.
- c. Audiovisual and communications equipment, such as televisions, computers, tape-recorders, cameras and telephones.
- d. Equipment for children's play activity areas, such as blocks, puzzles and dolls.
- e. Facilities for children and school staff, such as bathrooms, toilets, hand washing places, places of worship, kitchens, office spaces, sports rooms, rest/sleeping rooms, and meeting rooms.

Parental and Community Participation:

- a. Establish written communication through contact books.
- b. Hold regular meetings with parents.
- c. Create school programs that involve parents.
- d. Using communication technology facilities (telephone, e-mail, internet).
- e. Conduct home visits (home visits).
- f. Parental observations in class.

RPPH or RPH is a daily program plan that will be implemented by educators every day in accordance with the targets set at each level.

The daily learning methodology is:

- a. Muraja'ah memorize.
- b. Memorize new verses 2-3 verses/day.
- c. Evaluation (correcting the child's newly memorized reading).
